

Points from NRRF on 9 Jan to raise at RG on 14 Jan 2008

Following discussions, these are the main points which the NRRF agreed should be raised (or supported if other partners raise them) at the Regeneration Group (RG) meeting.

3. Area Based Grant	Some groups funded through the Children's Fund still do not know if they will receive funding next year even though the same amount of funding is pledged for next year as this. When will the Children's Fund proposed budget be made public?	
3. Area Based Grant	What happened to previous Neighbourhood Management funding (£3 million over three years?) was this all spent?	Phil
3. Area Based Grant	The residents are concerned about the reduction in funding for Neighbourhood Management and the impact this will have in the areas covered.	
3. Area Based Grant	Residents are also concerned at the proposed one-year £100,000 funding for Easton and Lawrence Hill Neighbourhood Management and the proposal to discuss follow on funding with Community at Heart. Community at Heart will only have one further year to run in 2009/2010 so it would be a very short-term arrangement.	
3. Area Based Grant	Will the Neighbourhood Partnership budget grow before the NM and NP become one? The proposed NP budget at the moment is very small (in comparison to NM) even though it is for a bigger area	
4. NR Transition Funding	How will resident involvement at the RG meeting be supported in the future with no funding for NRRF (or similar)?	
4. NR Transition Funding	Will there still be places for residents on the Regeneration Group and the Bristol Partnership after March?	
4. NR Transition Funding	What will happen to the NR facilitators in the neighbourhoods from March?	
4. NR Transition Funding	Why were the cross cutting initiatives in appendix 5 not subject to the prioritisation process like other NR initiatives?
