

Entry Requirements

There are 2 separate training routes / qualifications for the course – 1 at post graduate and 1 at graduate level.

For postgraduate (PGCert, PGDip, MSc = level 7) applicants would normally be required to have an honours degree (ie studied at level 6 in the national curriculum). A Grad Cert / Diploma programme is a level 6 qualification so we would normally expect an applicant to have some evidence of activity at level 5 (e.g. second year UG study or equivalent)

However, for graduate entry service's may well see some of these same abilities in applicants who don't necessarily have level 5 academic experience, but do have lots of experiential experience. As a result, if the candidate has for example only studied up to level 4 but has significant relevant experience then it is acceptable to support their application if they are a good candidate.
