Key Tasks & Responsibilities:

- Helping visitors to discover more by telling them facts, stories and anecdotes related to St Mary Redcliffe Church and its history.
- Adapting tours as necessary to meet the needs of different audiences, including any access and inclusion requirements they may have.
- Learning about the history of St Mary Redcliffe Church and sharing this with our visitors.
- Promoting guided tours and encouraging visitors to book tickets for these.
- In between tours, helping the Stewards to meet and greet visitors.
- To attend essential training as required e.g. Safeguarding, health and safety etc.
- Becoming familiar with and always following the St Mary Redcliffe's Health and Safety Policy.
- Giving any other appropriate assistance as may be reasonably requested.
- To ensure any safeguarding issues and/or concerns are reported to the St Mary Redcliffe Safeguarding Officer

Desirable Experience & Skills:

- Enthusiastic about St Mary Redcliffe Church, with an interest in its history and current tourism offer and ready to share this with our visitors.
- Good communicator and confident in speaking to people (adults and children) both individually and in a group context

- Ability to use own initiative and work independently.
- No qualifications or experience necessary, but a desire to work with the public is a must.
- An enthusiasm for relevant subjects (Christianity, history, art) desirable.
- A basic knowledge of safeguarding and how to protect vulnerable people from harm
