## Opportunity to Help Shape the Future of Bristol's Youth Services



Bristol City Council is currently looking for volunteers to help them develop Youth Services for Bristol. As someone who has already committed their time to supporting Bristol City Council we thought you may be interested in further developing this commitment by volunteering to become a Young Commissioner.

By agreeing to take on this role you will work with Bristol City Council staff to help consult on and co-develop Youth Services for Bristol. It is likely that this work will highlight the need for different types of services to be run in Bristol. You will

therefore also help to judge the suitability of organisations who wish to apply for funding to deliver these different services.

The role is open to Young People aged 11 – 19 (up to 25 if Learning Difficulties and Disabilities) who live in Bristol. It will be for approximately one year (starting in November 2016). You will be required to attend regular sessions but Bristol City Council will be flexible to accommodate other commitments you may have.

In return for volunteering you will receive training, travel expenses, £120 of reward vouchers (on completing agreed hours) and receive accreditation.

It will be an interesting opportunity to have a direct say in how services for young people will be run in Bristol in the future. This experience can be added to your CV which will look impressive to future colleges/ employers.

If you would like to take up this opportunity then we are going to have a taster session on Tuesday the 22<sup>nd</sup> of November, 5:15pm – 7:00pm at Bristol City Hall, College Green, Bristol, BS1 5TR. Food will be provided. You will need to confirm your interest by no later than Monday the 21<sup>st</sup> of November.

There will be additional sessions on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> December also if you can't make 22<sup>nd</sup> November.
